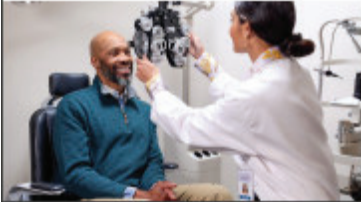
ALL-AMERICAN PRODUCTS AT VFW STORE
