Resolution No 10 Continue the MVTF Board Policy to Provide Assistance to Over Age 65 Peacetime Veterans

Whereas: The Board of the MVTF has established a policy to provide emergency financial assistance to peacetime residents of Michigan who are over the age of 65, and

Whereas: This policy has allowed the MVTF to assist veterans in need of assistance who otherwise would have difficulty obtaining assistance through other social service agencies or organizations, and

Whereas: This Board policy has not negatively impacted the Board's ability to meet its primary obligations to assist wartime veterans in need, therefore

Be it Resolved: That the Department of Michigan Veterans of Foreign Wars supports the continuation of the Michigan Veterans Trust Fund (MVTF) Board Policy to provide emergency financial assistance to Michigan peacetime veterans over the age 65 limited to the annually budgeted funds allocated to such a program under the Board's authority.
