

ALL-STATE CHECK LIST 2018-2019	
	Review your records and record the points of every program (starting May 1, 2019) that the Post participated in and return to Department Headquarters by April 30, 2019
	Post must be 100% in membership PLUS at least 1 new member
	A Post must be in good standing with all National and Department By-Laws
	Must have at least 150 points from below
	Ten (10) points – Post is 100% by November 30, 2018
	Eight (8) points – Post is 100% by December 31, 2018
	Six (6) points – Post is 100% by January 31, 2019
	Four (4) points - Post is 100% by February 28, 2019
	Three (3) points – Post is 100% by March 31, 2019
	Two (2) points – Post is 100% by April 15, 2019
	Points are not cumulative. If you are 100% in November 10 bonus points is all you get.
	New/Reinstated members - one (1) point for every new or reinstated member
	One (1) point for every percentage point (or fraction thereof) over 100%
	Americanism - one (1) point per month a Post submits an Americanism report to Department by the 10th of the month following the activity
	Americanism - three (3) points if a Post sponsors a Flag disposal ceremony and reports it to the Americanism Director
	Americanism - three (3) points if a Post sponsors a Loyalty Day ceremony and reports it to the Americanism Director
	Americanism - one (1) point if a Post member participates in a Loyalty Day program (other than the previously mentioned) [3 points maximum]
	Blue Star Mothers – one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department [four (4) points maximum]
	Buddy Poppy – five (5) points – if a Post purchases a minimum of 500 poppies by December 31, 2018
	Buddy Poppy – one (1) point for ordering more than previous year
	Camp Trotter – four (4) points for every child a Post financially sponsors during the camping season [sixteen (16) points maximum] to include children from the National Home. Post number, child's name(s) and amount donated must be reported to the All-State Director
	Camp Trotter – one (1) point for each life member a Post purchases [five (5) points maximum]
	Camp Trotter - one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates to Camp Trotter through Department [four (4) points maximum]
	Camp Trotter- one (1) point for every ten (10) hours donated to Camp Trotter [five (5) points maximum]
	Cancer – one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through the Department [four (4) points maximum]
	Community Service - one (1) point per month the post submits a Community Service Report
	Community Service - five (5) points if a New Member Community Service project is reported to Director by program deadline of April 1, 2019
	Community Service - one (1) point per month if the post submits a Community Service Report
	Community Service - five (5) points if an Outstanding Community Service project is reported to the Director by the deadline of April 1, 2019
	Commanders Special Project – one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department to Cancer [four (4) points maximum]

	Day of Challenges one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department [four (4) points maximum]
	Gold Star Mothers – one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department [four (4) points maximum]
	Hospital – one (1) point per month a Post submits a Hospital Report (12 Points Max)
	Legislative – one (1) point per month a Post submits a Legislative Report (12 Points Max)
	National Cemeteries - one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department [four (4) points maximum]
	National Home for Children – three (3) points if a Post registers its colors on Michigan Day
	National Home for Children – one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department [four (4) points maximum]
	National Home for Children - one (1) point for each life member a Post purchases [five (5) points maximum]
	Patriots Pen – five (5) points if a Post sponsors or co-sponsors a student to District for judging
	POW-MIA – five (5) points if a Post sponsors a program that involves the public and is reported to the Director
	POW-MIA – three (3) points if a Post sponsors a program at the Post and is reported to the POW-MIA Director
	POW-MIA - one (1) point if a Post member participates in a program (other than previously mentioned) [five (5) points maximum]
	Safety - one (1) point per month if a Post submits a drug report (12 Points Max)
	Safety - one (1) point per month if a Post submits a safety report (12 Points Max)
	Safety – five (5) points per category if Post submits a Firefighter, Law Enforcement or EMT of the Year (15 Points Max)
	Safety - three (3) points if a Post submits a name for a Life Saving Award [three (3) points maximum]
	Scouting - one (1) point for each \$25 donated through Department [four (4) points maximum]
	Scouting - four (4) points for each youth category (Eagle Scout of the Year, Girl Scout Gold Award of the Year and Venture Scout Summit/Quartermaster Award of the Year) the Post sponsors or co-sponsors and reports it to the Director April 1, 2019
	Scouting - five (5) points if a Post sponsors a new scouting unit and reports it to the Director
	Scouting - three (3) points if a Post supports any scouting unit and reports it to the Director
	Service Officers Class - three (3) points if a Post holds a class. Sign-in sheet must be sent to All-State Director
	Service Officers Class - three (3) points if a Post sends their service officer to a class. A report must be sent to the All-State Director
	Service Officers Class - one (1) point for any other Post member that attends a class [ten (10) points maximum]. A report must be sent to the All-State Director
	Teacher of the Year - five (5) points per category if Post sponsors or co-sponsors a teacher to district for judging. Grades K-5, 6-8 and 9-12 (15 Points Max)
	Veterans and Military Support – three (3) points if a Post purchases twenty (20) or more MAP Pins @ \$3.00 each. A report must be sent to the Veteran's and Military Support Director
	Veterans and Military Support – one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department to MAP [four (4) points maximum]
	Veterans and Military Support – one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department to Operation Uplink [four (4) points maximum]
	Veterans and Military Support – one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department of Adopt-a-Unit [four (4) points maximum]
	Veterans and Military Support – one (1) point for each \$25 or \$1 per member a Post donates through Department to the Unment Needs program [four (4) points maximum]

	Voice of Democracy – five (5) points if a Post sponsors or co-sponsors a student to District for judging.
	VTS –two (2) points per elected officer (Cmd, Sv, Jv, QM, Trustee and Adj) that attend a VTS
	VTS - one (1) point per Post member who attend VTS [fifteen (15) points maximum]
	VTS - two (2) points if a Post donates their hall for a VTS training
	Youth Activities – one (1) point per month when a Post submits a report to the Activities Evaluation Director (12 Points Max)
