Governor Whitmer has issued a "Stay Home, Stay Safe" executive order that directs Michiganders to stay in their homes unless they're a part of that critical infrastructure workforce, engaged in an outdoor activity such as exercise or walking the dog, or performing tasks necessary to the health and safety of themselves or their family, like going to the hospital or grocery store.

Effective at 12:01 am on March 24, 2020, for a least the next three weeks, individuals may only leave their home or place of residence under very limited circumstances, and they must adhere to social distancing measures recommended by the CDC, when they do so, including remaining at least six feet from others.
