- Preparing to update and send out furniture, office equipment, electrical and internet spread sheet to convention center contacts for items in each category that are required for the convention.

Administrative Operations

- There are currently 36 Posts under suspension. The organization has 5,629 chartered Posts.
- Administrative Operations is engaged in 20 Article IX Disciplinary Actions, 10 Administrative Removals/Actions and 11 membership eligibility challenges.
- Currently Administrative Operations has 141 Bylaws/Articles of Incorporation submissions in for review, 10 of which are new; current turnaround time on Bylaws/Articles of Incorporation submissions is approximately 45-60 days.

Department Approved Resolutions and Amendments:

This is a reminder to please send your Department-approved resolutions and/or amendments that require action to the National Bylaws, Manual of Procedure and Ritual Committee prior to the National Convention and immediately following the close of your Department Convention.

In order to meet the requirements mentioned in Article XIV of the National Bylaws/Manual of Procedure, stating "All proposed amendments will be available to Posts by the Adjutant General at least fifteen (15) days before the assembling of the National Convention for those amendments being proposed for consideration at the convention."

It is extremely important we receive these documents within two (2) days from the conclusion of your Department Convention. A response is required even if your Department does not have any resolutions/amendments to submit.

Election Reports:

The deadline for submitting a completed election report for the 2024-25 term has passed. The National Bylaws and Manual of Procedure require a properly completed Election Report be submitted to Department and National Headquarters by **June 1**. Please continue to work with Posts that have not met this requirement as we will begin suspending Posts after July 1 for failure to submit an election report for the 2024-25 term. This suspension by the Commander-in-Chief will result in the Post being placed in arrears and denied any representation at the National Convention.

To access the election report online; sign in to VFW.org and proceed to My VFW. Select Online Membership System (OMS), then press the drop-down menu on the left side of the screen for Election Report and select Post Election Report Filing.

Department Proof of Eligibility:

With the start of Department Conventions right around the corner I wanted to remind everyone of the requirement to submit proof of eligibility for all newly elected Junior Vice Commanders and any elected Department Quartermasters or appointed Department Adjutants who are new to their position this coming year (2024-25).

Additionally, proof of eligibility for any new Department Commanders or Senior Vice Commanders, who for whatever reason were not in the line of succession the previous year, to which we already have proof of eligibility on file.

This proof of eligibility must be submitted to the Adjutant General pursuant to Section 516 of the National Bylaws and Manual of Procedure.

This must be done <u>after</u> officers are installed and prior to National Convention and is most easily completed by sending documentation via email to Joseph Wolfgeher at JWolfgeher@vfw.org.

National Legislative Service

• VFW Testifies at House Subcommittee Oversight Hearing: VFW National Veterans Service Director Michael Figlioli testified at a House Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and

Memorial Affairs oversight hearing on the question of whether a rating of Total Disability based on Individual Unemployability (TDIU) properly compensates today's veterans. Eligible individuals receive a 100% disability rating if their service-connected disabilities preclude employment. Figlioli commented, "Discussions around TDIU often focus on financial aspects, but at its core it's about people whose lives have been irrevocably changed." Read the testimony or watch the hearing, which begins at the 14:21 mark.

• House Subcommittee Pending Legislation Hearing: VFW National Legislative Deputy Director Kristina Keenan provided a statement for the record on pending legislation to the House Veterans' Affairs Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity. The proposed bills included H.R. 7543, *Guard and Reserve GI Bill Parity Act of 2024*, which is a VFW top legislative priority. It recognizes the sacrifices that National Guard and Reserve members make when serving stateside, during short activations, and on long deployments. It would allow any day in uniform receiving military pay to count toward Post-9/11 GI Bill eligibility. Keenan wrote, "For years, the sacrifices of Guard and Reserve service members have been overlooked in achieving GI Bill eligibility. The time is now for parity with all the armed forces in earning VA education benefits." Read the testimony.
