Post Building Relief & Transformation Grant Program

Posts can apply for a one-time grant between \$1,000-\$10,000. Posts who are awarded this grant must wait one whole grant cycle before being eligible to apply for a second award. There will be five grants awarded. Applications are due by 11:59 PM EST on November 1, 2022.



Eligibility

- Posts applying for grant must have a building
- Funding request must pertain to building maintenance, upgrades, or transformation
- Post must be in good standing with the VFW Department of Michigan and be up to date with all state and federal filing requirements
- Post must have all audits submitted to the VFW Department of Michigan

Grantee Obligation

If selected for this grant, the post recipient must send one elected officer of the post and another officer or member/director of the post to a leadership workshop organized by the VFW Department of Michigan. At this leadership workshop, a strategic plan will be created collaboratively to assist long-term growth of the post.

Veteran Outreach & Support Grant

Posts can apply for a one-time grant between \$500-\$2,500. Posts can be awarded this grant once per year. There will be 10-15 grants awarded. Applications are due by 11:59 PM EST on November 1, 2022.



Eligibility

- Post must be in good standing with the VFW Department of Michigan and be up to date with all state and federal filing requirements
- Post must have all audits submitted to the VFW Department of Michigan
- Posts must provide a plan detailing what type of event funds will be used for (i.e. panel discussion, fair, game night, etc.). If funds will be used for unique programs, provide a description of how funds will be used (i.e. helping veterans start businesses, job placement/apprenticeships, community resource center, etc.)
